Shantanu's Story

[JESUS IS OUR LEAD STORY]

Shantanu Sharma was born and raised in New Delhi, India as a member of the Brahmin caste—the highest religious caste in Hinduism. Needless to say, he was steeped in religion from the moment he was born. After coming to the United States for graduate school at Duke University, he met a girl named Savannah, who invited him to Passion City Church. Shantanu was incredibly smart and logical, and thought if there were many ways to the same God, why would he give up being in the highest caste in Hinduism to follow some historical figure named Jesus? Sunday after Sunday he would show up to church, but Savannah noticed Shantanu scrolling on his phone during the gatherings, so she sneakily signed him up to be a Door Holder. It was here that God started surrounding him with amazing believers, including many from India. He also got connected to a Monday night bible study with other men in his same stage of life who would pray for him and point him towards Jesus.

There were many Sundays when he would hear Pastor Louie speak about historical documents that validated scripture, and he even read the book “The Case for Christ,” where he saw the logical thread in the story of Jesus. But he was still trying to understand how He was the only way. The guys in his bible study, the Door Holders he served with, and Savannah would continue to be on their knees and pray for his eyes to be opened to the way of Jesus.

Shantanu began to read God's Word, and when he came upon John 14:6, it was like Jesus' words were illuminated on the page. Jesus says about himself, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” It was so clear to him at that moment... no one comes to God except through Jesus. There are not multiple paths to one God, but it is only through Jesus that we can have eternal life with Him.

As he continued to attend church, he felt the nudge week after week to raise his hand during the response at the end of the gathering, but this was such a big step, and he had many hesitations. It would be extremely hard to share with his Hindu parents and other family members about his decision to follow this man named Jesus. But one Sunday, Pastor Grant was preaching on Ephesians, and at the end of the message when he asked if anyone would like to surrender their lives to Jesus, Shantanu could not keep his hand down any longer. He surrendered everything to Jesus and went from death to LIFE!

This story is a testimony to some of the most important parts of our House. One, an incredible church family that loved Shantanu and pointed him toward Jesus. Two, many people were praying for Shantanu to come to know Jesus. And three, because God's Word is central to everything we do, His Word doesn't

return void. It accomplished its purposes and judged the thoughts and attitudes of Shantanu's heart. Because of that, he is alive forever in Jesus.

Savannah and Shantanu went through UNITE Marriage Mentorship and eventually got married. You may see their bright smiles on a Sunday at our 515 location serving on the Experience Team.

Just a few months ago, Shantanu made an important step in his journey to be baptized. Moments before, he paused and prayed with his baptizer specifically that what God did in his story would have an eternal impact on people who were attending the gatherings that day and that someone would come to know Jesus as a result. That same day, two girls who were attending Passion for the first time that Sunday were experimenting with world religions, and would consider themselves ‘religious’, but searching for truth. Through hearing Shantanu's story and the word brought that day, one of the girls, Monique, realized that it wasn't enough to just know the truth; she wanted that ‘death to life’ moment for herself and decided to put her faith and trust in Jesus.

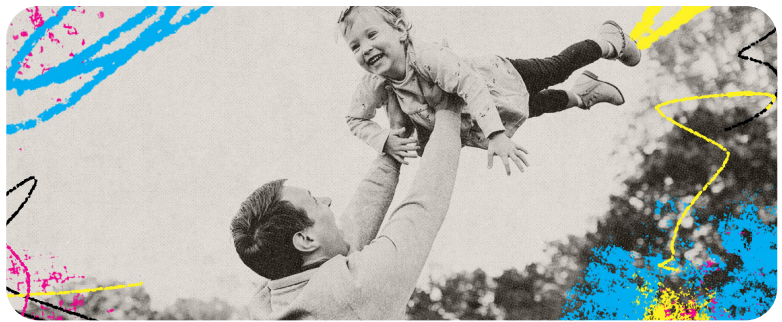

Dear Passion City Church,

The day we heard the word “cancer”, our world felt shattered. We held tightly our 23-month-old daughter, Holland, as we sat in shock and disbelief. Our joyful, happy, blue-eyed baby was sick. Very sick. The 48 hours that followed were a blur...a mixture of grief and tears, all while making rapid and hard decisions. We were scared, and we were hurting. But within hours of Holland’s diagnosis.....there you were—the Church. Texting, calling, and praying around the clock. What our family witnessed in the months that followed was stunning.

We were cared for in the most tender and loving way that radiated Jesus to us in our hardest moments. We didn’t cook a meal for eight months straight because our church family just kept showing up with more food. When we arrived home from the hospital, our fridge was stocked, and sticky notes penned with Scripture filled our home. Time after time, our church family prayed in the hospital’s parking lot, just so they could be near us as they called on Jesus for a miracle. Friends (every one of them from a relationship we formed in this House) kept our younger daughter while we took Holland for weekly chemo appointments. No one expected anything in return; they simply served us, loved us, cried with us, and cared for us.

I could fill page upon page recounting the ways our family was met with kindness during our daughter’s journey with cancer. But mostly, our church family was there. They were present. They pursued us and called on Jesus with us, and that’s what family does. They celebrate on the mountain, and they cling tight when the valley seems dark. Today, Holland shows no evidence of cancer in her body, and you’ll find her every week in bloom—laughing, playing and thriving!

We’ve witnessed a complete miracle that only Jesus could do. Thank you for being family. For being generous people who have helped make church so much more than a building. Whether we know each other personally or not, you are a part of our story. Your generosity has helped create a place for people to be known, cared for and connected.

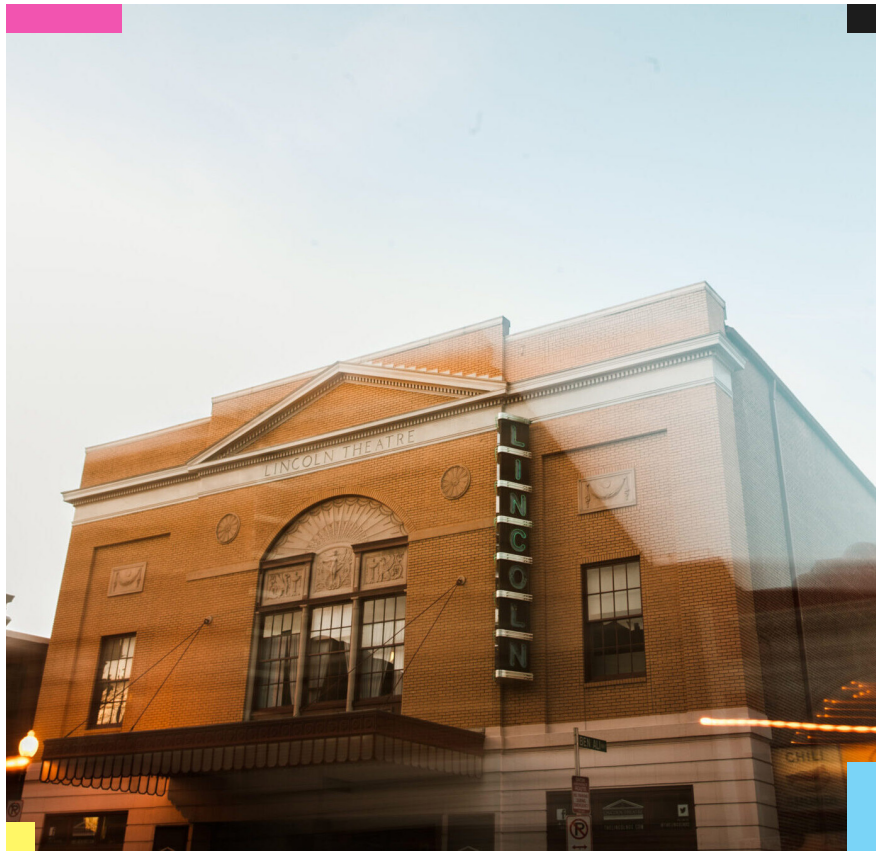

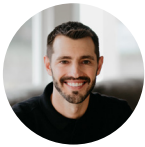

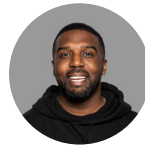

JOHN'S STORY

[THE GOSPEL IS CENTRAL]

John's four years of college were filled with poor decisions. Alcohol, drugs, and partying dominated his life. He had the keys to the candy store, yet still, he felt empty. He thought that searching the world and trying everything once would fulfill him, but he was overwhelmed by guilt and loneliness.

A bad relationship led John to listen to Pastor Ben Stuart's sermon online on dating. "Wow", he thought to himself, "this guy gets it right". Battling thoughts of depression, feeling unworthy and too far gone, the Lord led John through the doors of Passion City Church DC at The Howard Theatre in August 2019. On that day, his life started to change. It did not happen overnight, but over time, his eyes were opened to what he had been yearning for. The Lord gave him a strong group of God-fearing men to rally around him, but above all, John had a desire to rekindle his relationship with Jesus. This has impacted his life beyond anything he could have imagined, and his community celebrated with him as he made the choice to be baptized and proclaim a life of following Jesus.

After settling into Passion City Church and rekindling his relationship with the Lord, God revealed to John that it was time for him to move on from some things that were holding him back. It was the goodness of God that led him to let go of what was holding him back, and for the past three years, John has been sober from drugs and alcohol. "The goodness of God leads us to repentance." Romans 2:4

John quickly learned that dedicating your life to following Jesus does not guarantee that challenges will cease. Not long after that moment, John was let go from his job as a substitute teacher and football coach. But in the middle of the storm, his community at Passion City Church came and walked with him through it. They rallied around him with prayers and reassurance that God was preparing something new for him. One night, John attended a Passion City Church Community Group in Rosslyn and sat next to a guy who happened to be a football coach. After connecting, they both realized they played college football in Ohio and had a few mutual connections. John grabbed his new friend's number and the two stayed connected. A few weeks later, he reached out to John to let him know that a new coaching and teaching position had become available at his school.

Now, John has the opportunity to mentor and pray for young men regularly, many of whom have put their faith in Jesus as a result of the bible study he's been able to lead them through. The Lord works all things for the good of those who love Him, and He has used the destructive, messy parts of John's past for His good. He has been set free by the love of God and is using his story to tell others of the hope he's found in Jesus.

John's life is a testament to the countless lives being transformed by the gospel in Washington, DC.

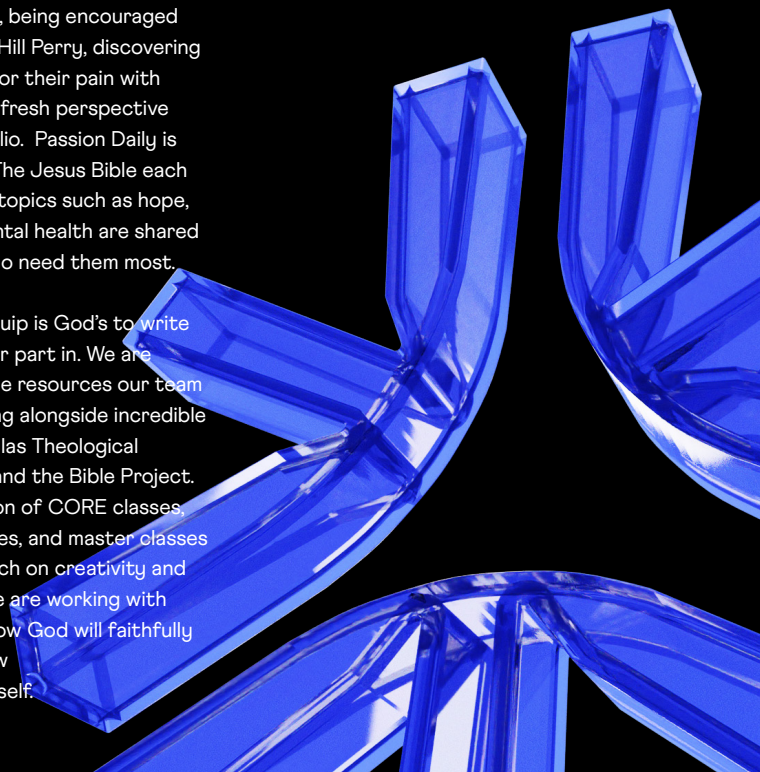

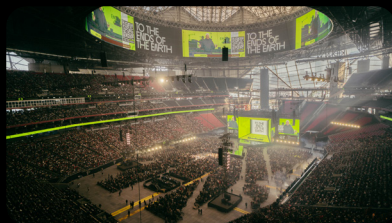

Beverly came to Georgia from Philadelphia/New Jersey, where she was born and raised. She made her way south to work in the film industry at Trilith, and was hired on with multiple well-known production companies to work in the arts department as a set dresser. Although she felt like she was living out her calling, it was a struggle being away from her home church, and she felt like every encounter she had with a church since being here was shallow, at best. One day, she saw a card for Passion City Church in the coffee shop, but was so discouraged by her search that she just threw it in her pocket and went on with her day.

One day, she was having a hard time, so she went into the office of one of her co-workers, Holly Jordan, who she knew had a relationship with Jesus and mentioned that she was ready to go home and be with her church family. Holly then mentioned the “church across the street” in the TV studios, which was Passion City Church, and encouraged her to try it out. Although she was hesitant to do so, the first moment she stepped into the room, she felt the heart and desire for God, and the hunger for worship in a way she had not seen since she attended her church back home. She knew at that moment that she had found her new home. Since that Sunday, Beverly has hardly missed a week and has gotten plugged in as a Door Holder in bloom and Students at Trilith. Not only that, but she has also been connected to lead a Young Adults group, and her co-leader, Kim Ramsey, has become like a sister to her. It’s such a beautiful picture of church not being just an organization to attend, but a family to belong to.

But God’s reach doesn’t stop there. Beverly has a winsome spirit, and through interactions with a co-worker named Elle, who was searching for a truth to be rooted in, she invited her to church. Elle’s life has now been transformed by the gospel, and she has found amazing community and now serves in family ministries at Trilith.

Beverly mentioned that the film industry is dark, and some days, she feels like giving up and walking away from it all. Sometimes she feels like she might be the only light in the industry. But her new church family constantly reminds her that in ALL things, we do it for the glory of God, and she has no idea what is on the other side of her obedience to step into those spaces.

When we started Passion City Church at Trilith, we prayed that God would use us to be a light and influence in the film industry. It’s so clear that He’s working in ways seen and unseen. People like Beverly, Elle, and Holly are having their lives impacted by all God is doing through Passion City Church, and they are being shot out like flaming arrows of His Glory into an industry that needs Him desperately.

The first moment she stepped into the room, she felt the heart and desire for God, and the hunger for worship in a way she had not seen since she attended her church back home. She knew at that moment that she had found her new home.

In 2020, through the generosity of our House, Passion City Church was able to give a van to one of our local partners, Agape Recovery Center. This van is utilized to serve individuals who are working to gain genuine, long-term freedom from their substance abuse and addictive thinking. Many Sundays since then, that van headed to Cumberland filled with men & women working towards freedom and excited to worship with us at Passion City Church.

In 2022, we told the story of Brittney, who was stuck in a life of addiction but boarded the van given through Above + Beyond and stepped into Passion City Church for the first time. She encountered the grace and forgiveness of Jesus and put her faith in him. In March of that year, Brittney was baptized, declaring that she had been made new in Jesus and freed from the chains that once bound her.

The story doesn't end here, and we continue to see God's faithfulness through your generosity.

In September 2023, Tammy hit rock bottom and entered Agape Recovery Center after spiraling into an eight-year addiction to alcohol after losing her husband to a short and painful battle with cancer. For years, her daughter Tina prayed and contended that her mom would truly find her own faith and belief in Jesus and be freed from the addiction

that had wrecked her and their family's lives. One Sunday, while in the program at Agape, she rode in the same van our House gifted the ministry to our Cumberland location. During the 11:45 gathering that day, seven people put their faith in Jesus...including Tammy! She put her lightbulb in the Jesus is Life wall, and today, she's eight months sober, working, and seeing other women who are walking through the program at Agape come to church in that same van that changed her life.

It's beautiful to see that in the economy of God, He can take what seems like a small act of generosity and transform dozens of lives for years to come. If you gave in 2020, thank you. Your generosity is paving the way so that men and women are putting their faith in Jesus, chains of addiction are being broken, and families are being put back together.

BLOOM FOSTER CARE

Bloom is a refuge where foster children can find safe, nurturing foster families with the training and support to help them heal, and free resources like clothing, school supplies, and toys so they can focus on thriving.

God is doing great things at Bloom, and it would not be happening without your generous support! Through your generosity, volunteer efforts, and items that stock The Bloom Closet and Bloom Closet Express, their team served over 6,800 foster children across the state of Georgia. The Bloom Closet visited a group home and met a girl who had just been placed into foster care. Her life had been completely turned upside down when she was abruptly removed from her home with nothing but the clothes on her back. She was in a new city, new school, and new home with unfamiliar people; her life as she knew it was gone. She even started experiencing bullying. As soon as she began shopping on the Bloom Closet Express, her demeanor changed. With each item she picked out—clothing, shoes, makeup, accessories—her confidence grew. By the end of her shopping trip, she was beaming with joy. The purpose behind their programs is not only to provide children with essential items needed to thrive in foster care, but also to make them feel seen and loved. Through their efforts, they help these children regain their sense of dignity and self-worth, despite their circumstances.

The Table On Delk provides a safe place, meals, and resources for those who are currently, or at risk of, being sexually exploited on Delk Road in Atlanta, Ga.

God's timing is perfect! The Table on Delk had just committed to support two of their friends who needed a very high level of recovery (at a very high price!) when they received news of the \$25,000 gift from Passion City Church through the 2023 ABOVE + BEYOND giving! This gift provided for nearly one year of their rent and utilities, which allows them to remain a 'constant' in their friends' chaotic world and remind them that God sees them, loves them, and has a better plan for them. In addition to serving women and children currently or at risk of being sexually exploited, The Table is the 'local church' to our folks on Delk Road. They offer Bible studies

for boys, girls, and women, and Celebrate Recovery for everyone in the community. Your giving allowed them to purchase more Bibles for everyone and even provide each woman with a copy of Don't Give the Enemy a Seat at Your Table when they studied Psalm 23. They saw many women experience freedom; to come to understand the intense battle for their minds and how to take back the ground they unintentionally gave up.

THE HOUSE DC

The House DC's mission is to transform and empower at-risk youth, their families, and their neighborhoods by breaking cycles and building futures of hope through the love of Jesus

The House DC is profoundly grateful that the generosity from our Above and Beyond campaign has had a tremendous impact on their inner city youth ministry and is making a real difference in the community. With your gift, they were able to provide nutritious meals for the youth in their after-school program, distribute meals to those in need within the community through their street ministry, and provide snacks, arts & crafts, and supplies for their weekly children's church (The Club House). Not only that, but they were able to update the equipment in their recording studio, which offers students a creative and safe space to express their emotions and experiences through music. This initiative is especially meaningful, as the studio is managed by a former House DC student who is now giving back to the community in the same way he was supported during his high school years.

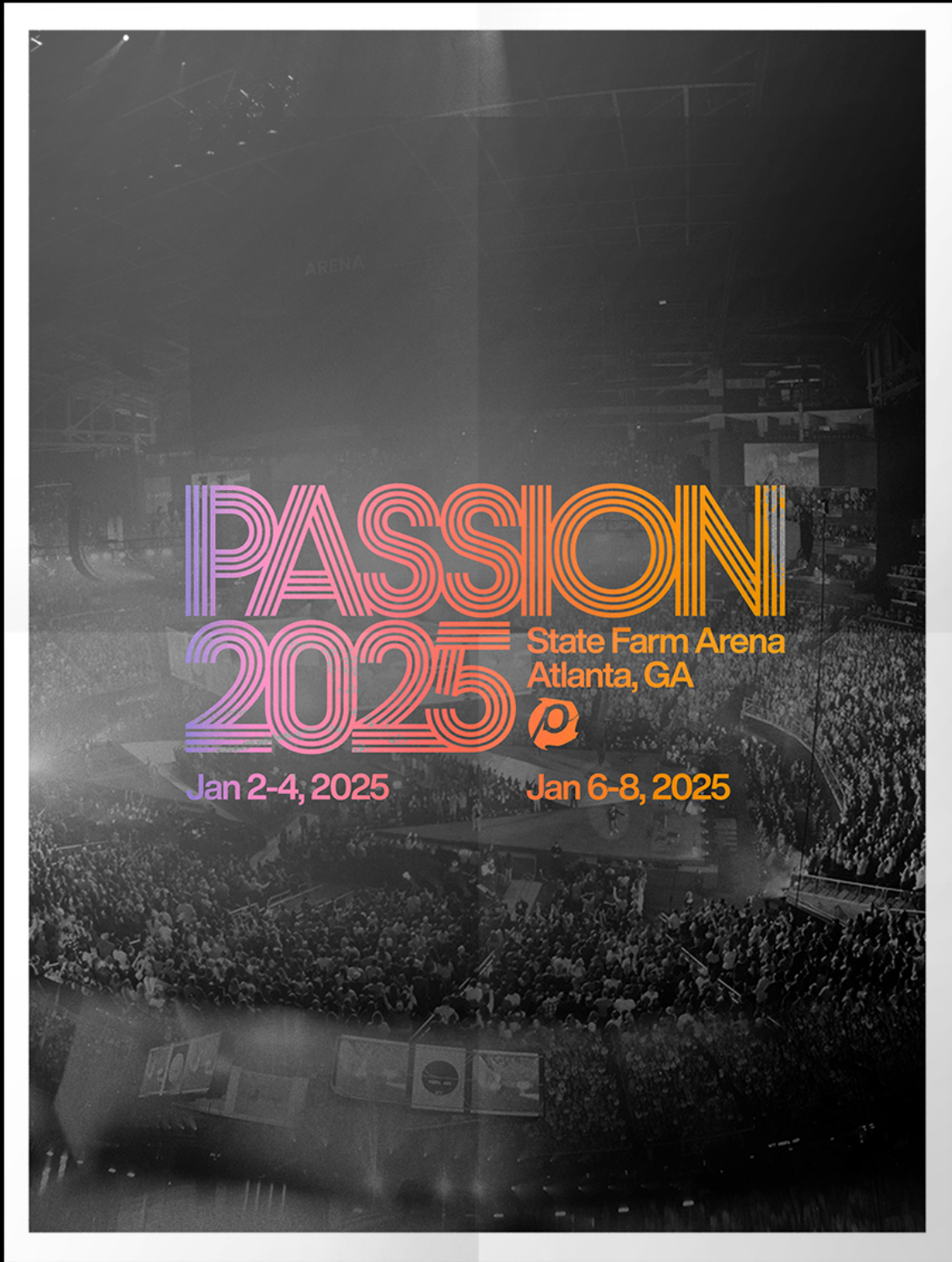

Ethne Health delivers comprehensive, high-value healthcare through a culturally sensitive, neighbor-centered medical home that advances Jesus' love and justice in our vibrant Clarkston community.

On October 31st of last year, Ethne Health Clinic opened the doors to Ethne Dental. Their patient population is primarily made up of refugees, and many of the patients they serve have rarely, if ever, been to a dentist. Because of your generous gift, they were able to complete the renovation and transformation of their old offices into Ethne Dental. A 15-year-old Dari-speaking Afghan teenage girl first came to Ethne Dental with her mother, who had a tooth that needed to be extracted. She later came in as a patient herself. Several years ago, while in her home country, she fell on some furniture and fractured her top two front teeth. Due to many reasons, she was unable to have it fixed in her home country or here in the U.S. Imagine being a young teenage woman with broken front teeth and how much that could affect her self-esteem and potentially how others would treat her. She was eager to have her teeth restored, which Ethne was able to do with a completely natural look. This not only has the potential to restore some lost dignity to this young girl, but give her a sense of significance in a new country she now calls home.

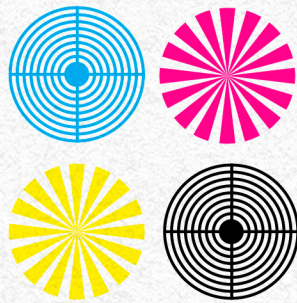
GENEROSITY IS NORMAL
